
About me:

About the site:

Avon Meadows Community Wetland is a designated Local Nature Reserve located on the West bank of the River Avon in Pershore, Worcestershire. The 23 Ha site comprises approximately 13 Ha of unimproved neutral grassland Floodplain Meadow together with roughly 5½ Ha of artificially created Wetland, plus scrubland, riparian margins, footpaths, ditches and hedges.





Site monitoring:

Extensive biological record keeping is carried out across the whole site. Specifically for the grassland the following are monitored:

- Hydrology: Weekly levels from 10 strategically placed dipwells
- Soil Fertility: Annual analyses of soil samples from
 3 key areas
- •Species diversity: Annual monitoring of 5 quadrats in each of 2 (to be increased to 3) key areas.
